

# Guidelines

1. Containers must be at the curb by 6 a.m. on your pick-up day and taken back from the curb within 24-hours of pickup. They should have 3 feet of clearance on each side to ensure our truck can safely pick it up. Trash must be bagged and placed in the city provided trash container.
2. Yard waste is not permitted in trash containers. It must be placed in biodegradable paper bags and set out with your trash. Larger tree limbs must be tied with natural fiber. Individual limbs can be no longer than 3ft. and 50 lbs.
3. Recycling will be collected from residents participating in the Recycling Program by renting a blue container. We accept Cardboard-Aluminum-Metal-Paper and Plastics #1-5 and #7. Please flatten cardboard and ensure that items are clean. Residents are not required to separate or bag their recyclable items.

## Bulk Items

Larger items such as lumber and furniture will not be picked up with your regular trash. Anything placed outside of your cart is considered a Special Pickup and come with a \$17 additional charge. Please call the Solid Waste Division to schedule pick-up of such items.

## Cleanup Weeks

## Hazardous and Electronic Waste

Residents can dispose of household hazardous and electronic waste for free at the City's Household Hazardous Waste Collection Center. It is located behind the Fire Station No. 1 on Tennyson Road. Collections take place on the second Saturday of each month April through October. Appointments are required.

Items such as acid, paint strippers, cameras, smoke detectors, rodent poison, and batteries qualify as hazardous waste. TVs are not accepted. A full list is available at [fultonmo.org/utilities](http://fultonmo.org/utilities)
