ELTON HENSLEY AIRPORT Contact List & Emergency Response Procedures

Primary Contacts

Airport Manager, Matt Easley

☎ 573-544-6906

- Contact for all airport-related questions, concerns, or needs.
- **In the event of an emergency, contact *after* calling 911.**
- If unavailable, immediately call the City of Fulton Power Plant to relay a message.

City of Fulton Power Plant

☎ 573-592-3180

- Contact for after-hours support.
- Use if the Airport Manager does not respond, *after* contacting 911 in an emergency.

City Engineer (Interim), Darrell Dunlap

☎ 573-592-3111

- Oversees all aspects of airport operations and directs the Airport Manager.
- Reviews and manages all airport-related projects.

Incident / Accident Response Protocol

- **Always follow the contact steps listed above.**
- **If an aircraft incident involves injury or fatality:**
 - Call the **NTSB 24-Hour Response Line** at **1-844-373-9922**
 - **Do not contact the FAA directly.**
- **For non-injury incidents** (e.g., crash, runway overrun):
 - FAA notification is the **pilot's responsibility** within 10 days.
 - Treat as a standard vehicle accident report process.
 - **Do not contact the FAA directly.**
- Contact the **Airport Manager** or **City Engineer** for additional guidance or coordination needs.

Runway Entry Safety for Emergency Responders

- **Tune radios to 122.7 MHz** when entering the runway area.
- Communicating with aircraft in the area is critical for safety.
- **Do not rely solely on emergency vehicle lights**—pilots may not see them until it is too late.
- Ensuring life safety is the top priority. Maintain communication and proceed with caution.
